1. Downright Special Fridays Group Volunteers

- Helping ensure our Friday sessions run smoothly
- Make teas/coffees and preparing snacks for the children
- Assist the teaching staff in setting up and clearing up the toys, equipment and resources
- Every Friday morning in term time
- This opportunity is open to all and we would particularly welcome applications from people with Down syndrome.

2. Downright Special Fridays Volunteer Cover Teacher

- Provide help with the delivery of our intervention group for children aged 1-2 to cover for when the group lead is unavailable.
- This would be an excellent opportunity for someone thinking of a future role in the education of children with additional needs who would like to gain hands-on experience of working with children with SEN
- Every Friday morning in term-time.

3. Downright Special Fridays Dance Teacher

- Lead a short music and movement session to work on the children's balance, core strength and body-awareness skills.
- Provide any other help with as required or as much as you have time for!
- Sessions take place as part of our Downright Special Fridays groups with the dance session from 10am – 10.15am approx.
- Every Friday morning in term time.
